

NIDAT Minutes
November 13, 2019

Ethnic Lunch Survey:

April developed a short 8-question survey to generate feedback from food vendors on what can be improved for next year's lunch event. It will be sent out via e-mail; Jane has the contacts and will use a survey platform to help tabulate results easily.

Art/Writing Contest:

Katie was in attendance and would be working with NIACC. Beem Center is a likely candidate as the venue to have the art and writing awarding ceremony. She inquired about invitations on the previous years and mentioned that it will be good to invite the mayor to re-ignite support from the city. Katie plans to be in contact with Ashley Heffern to bounce ideas and broaden participation.

The \$500 Farrer grant will be deposited with the plans going forward to do the Art/Writing contest. Katie will get back with a date to move this forward.

Grant status:

The \$5K check came in as noted in the treasurer's report. Dan usually works on the Farrer grant in April and the Principal grant in May. These will be for future programs and activities for 2021.

Bill called the meeting to adjourn. Dan made a motion, this was seconded by Diane. Motion passed and meeting adjourned at 5:06 pm.
